This memorial scholarship was established in 2004 in memory of Firefighter Chad Schapansky, Clearwater Volunteer Fire Department, who lost his life fighting a fire in his community of Clearwater, BC. The scholarship will be awarded to an applicant **who is a volunteer firefighter in British Columbia who wishes to further their education** at a Canadian Training Facility to pursue a career as a full time firefighter.
