Fire Departments with members completing new JIBC vocational firefighter programs aligned with the requirements established in the Structure Firefighters Competency and Training Playbook are encouraged to apply.

Everyone taking the course is required to review all the content on the course website and complete an online exam (with a 75% passing grade). An outline of the course [is available](#) on the FSD's [Playbook Updates](#) page.

At this time, the JIBC Evaluator Course is for existing JIBC Evaluators and new training officers pursuing certification to become Evaluators for the new Exterior, Interior and Full Service Fire Fighter Operations programs. Completion of the course excludes certification to be Evaluators for Live Fire and Hazmat courses. In the future, all FSD Evaluators will need to complete the course. More information will become available when we expand this course to other FSD courses and programs.
